INTRODUCING THE NEW TRANSLATION OF THE MASS – Today we will begin to use the new Translation of the Mass. If you wish to read more about the Translation copies of “Praying the Mass” are available from the Repository. Special editions of “Praying the Mass for Children” will be available, we hope, in the next couple of weeks. Going against all my liturgical principles we shall have for the present time missalettes with copies of the text that you will say or sing during the Mass. By the First Sunday of Advent in 12 weeks’ time the new Missal will be ready and we shall use the prayers from it. We will then have instead of missalettes copies of the Parish Mass Book with all the new text. So we will have in our hands all the readings and prayers of the Mass. This book is familiar to many and some already use it. We shall also be using the new missal chants in the next 12 weeks thanks to our Choirs, who are ahead of the game and have learned the chants. We shall use the chants at Mass as the Bishop has asked us to become familiar with them. I ask everyone to make a special effort to be part of the changes and help us to introduce them.
