THINK ABOUT THIS

“One of the key words in Christianity is Eucharist. Eucharist is at the centre of our worship. It should also have a central place in our thought processes. It would not be appropriate for a follower of Christ, for someone regularly nourished at the table of the Eucharist, to go through life more conscious of what is missing in their lives than they are appreciative the blessings that have come their way. It is not only spiritually desirable that we have an appreciative mentality, a Eucharistic mentality: it is psychologically desirable as well. Am I as Eucharistic, as grateful for life's blessings, in my thinking as I ought to be? If not perhaps I should ask the Lord, present in the Eucharist, to help me become more Eucharistic.”
