PEACE SUNDAY, 20 JANUARY – "*Blessed are the Peacemakers*", the theme for the 46th World Peace Day, fits very well with the aim of the Year of Faith. It is taken from the 7th of the 9 Beatitudes which begins Jesus' public ministry. But what does it mean for us today? To understand the Beatitudes properly, it is important to see that they are not instructions. Rather, they are descriptions of how '*Kingdom People*': poor in spirit, compassionate, gentle, thirsty for righteous, merciful, pure in heart, peace-making, persecuted and spoken ill of. Seeking the Kingdom gets them into trouble. But signs of the Kingdom of God happen if [and only if] people dare to live that way.
