HUMAN DISASTER – URGENT APPEAL

You will be aware that East Africa is currently experiencing the worst drought in almost 60 years, affecting people in Somalia, Kenya, Ethiopia, Sudan & Eritrea. The number of people affected is immense, with tens of thousands already on the move in search of water, pasture and food. The estimate of those affected is 3.2 million in Ethiopia and 3.1 million in Kenya with an overall estimate of up to 10 million people in the whole region. Given the gravity of the situation and the urgent need to respond quickly, CAFOD has decided to launch an appeal and emergency response with immediate effect. This is a £5m appeal. CAFOD has over 30 years experience of working with the Church across East Africa. The extensive community networks of the Church and its traditional role in supporting those most in need at times of crisis mean it is uniquely placed to act. Currently CAFOD staff are placed in Kenya, Ethiopia and Sudan and CAFOD has already committed over £300,000 to the crisis response in the past 3 months. Many demands are being placed on parishes and the financial pressure being suffered by so many people in our community at this time is serious. Despite this I am asking for your understanding and support for this very urgent appeal. As always I know that OLOL Parishioners will be generous. Contributions may be Gift Aided.
