**THURSDAY 1 NOVEMBER** – Is the Feast of All Saints. Friday 2 November is the Feast of All Souls, Commemoration of the Faithful Departed. In the Catholic tradition All Souls is a day when we remember our beloved dead and pray for them. There will be 3 Masses on that day- 9am, Funeral Mass at 3pm and Evening Mass at 8pm.

**THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER** – It is understandable for us to sometimes wonder what happens after we die? I can't fully answer that question but the following story may help.

**A sick man said to his doctor, "Doctor, I am afraid to die. Tell me what lies on the other side". The doctor replied very quietly "I don't know." "You don't know! You are a Christian and you don't know what's on the other side?"**

**The doctor was holding the handle of the door. From the other side came the sound of scratching and whining and as he opened the door a dog sprang into the room and leapt on him with great happiness. Turning to his patient the doctor said "Did you notice my dog? He's never been in this room before. He didn't know what was inside. He knew nothing except that his master was here. I know little of what is on the other side of death but I do know one thing.... I know my Master is there and that is enough."**

Throughout November we remember those 'on the other side' and we ask the Lord to open the door to his presence. We do so because our love for them reaches beyond the grave and expresses itself in our prayer for their joy and happiness. If you wish prayers to be said for your beloved dead and to be remembered in Masses please put their names on a slip of paper and place in the box which will be at the front of the church in November.

**NOVEMBER: HOLY SOULS** – November is the month of the Holy Souls in the Catholic tradition. Mass for deceased parishioners will be celebrated on Wednesday 7 November at 7.30pm in the Church, and in the City of London cemetery on Saturday 24 November at 11.30am. If you wish to have Masses celebrated for deceased family and friends, use the Mass Intentions envelopes at the back of the Church.
