HOLOCAUST MEMORIAL DAY – 27 JANUARY 2019

In cities and towns across the United Kingdom, events will be held to mark the liberation of Auschwitz and to remember the evil and injustice which has characterized genocide wherever it has appeared. Holocaust Memorial Day puts us on our guard against what happens when prejudice and racism are allowed to go unchallenged. This year, the theme chosen for Holocaust Memorial Day is “Torn from Home”. It invites us to reflect on what it must be like to be forced out of what we have known as “home”. This is what happened in the middle of the 20th Century to millions of Jews and others who were used as slave labour. Few ever saw “home” again. Many were murdered as part of the Nazis organized programme of annihilation.
