ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

From the 1st March, Friday Adoration will continue until 4pm. You are encouraged, if you can, to spend time and prayer between 9.30am and 4.00pm on Fridays. Perhaps parents on the way to collect children from school would like to come in for a short time of prayer.

HELP WANTED PLEASE

We require a number of new liturgical items for our Church.

- (1) **A Thurible** (Censer) used at Benediction, Blessed Sacrament, Funerals, 11.30am Sunday Sung Mass etc. It is a very important symbolic item of our prayers ascending to the Father and a mark of respect for the altar and crucifix.
- (2) **A Wooden Lectern** for the sanctuary of the church, placed in front of the presiders chair. This would have to be of good quality oak wood.
- (3) **Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament** is a very special feature in our community, taking place daily at 8.30am and nearly all day on Friday and also during the year 40 hours of continuous Adoration and Prayer. Pope Francis has encouraged us in this devotion and has asked that people be invited to spend time in adoration and prayer. In order to remind people of this we are placing a large sign on a notice board outside the church to invite people to come in to this beautiful devotion. The banner has been donated by a parishioner and we are now asking for donations toward the notice board. It will have to be a strong structure and made to order. Donations towards this would be much appreciated. It is part of our evangelisation and proclamation of the Gospel. Any donations large or small to the above will be gratefully received. If donating please ensure your donation is gift aided. Items can be donated in memory of a loved one, and their names will be included in our masses for parishioners living and dead during the year.
