SHAPING OUR FUTURE

Our Steward of the Gospel, Anne-Marie Fox, the Chair of our Parish Council, Fiona Christison and Father Pat, attended a meeting with the Stewards, Chairs and Priests from St Anne Line Parish and St. Thomas of Canterbury at St. Thomas parish centre last Tuesday evening. A wide ranging and in depth discussion took place on the way forward and different models of partnership were discussed. A consultation of parish councils will take place and feedback will be given at the next meeting where hopefully we will discern a way forward. Our Lady of Lourdes parish council has opted for a formal parish partnership with a linking/cooperation agreement. In the near future it is hoped that the partnership will come together for prayer and social events. All this is in response to the Bishop's document, 'Shaping our Future in the Diocese of Brentwood'. It is envisaged that two priests will serve the three parishes – known as a partnership.
