*Dear Parishioners,*

Attending weekday and Sunday mass is now a different experience than in the past. In keeping with Government and Church guidelines - new rules and regulations have to be observed. Parishioners are asked to be patient and understanding and have realistic expectations.

For the first time in the history of our parish, we have had to turn people away from the church, because of capacity numbers. We are observing faithfully the rules to ensure the health and safety of all.

Due to physical distancing and guidelines, only a limited number can attend each mass. At present, the obligation to attend Sunday mass is suspended. We are now increasing our number of parish masses to give everyone a reasonable opportunity to attend mass sometime during the week.

From Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> November, there will be an 8am Sunday mass, now providing five Sunday masses: Saturday 6.30pm, Sunday 8.00am, 9.30am, 11.30am and 6.30pm. Daily morning mass Monday to Saturday at 9am, with an evening mass on Fridays at 7.30pm (we shall monitor attendance at the Friday evening mass and if sufficient numbers attend it will continue for the foreseeable future).

Friday evening mass at 7.30pm will commence on 30<sup>th</sup> October.

With the COVID-19 virus on the increase again (as we face the winter) it is of paramount importance that we follow the guidelines: limiting social contact, keep physical distance, wash hands, sanitize hands and wear a face mask.

In order to help the priests make provision for your spiritual needs, we need you to help us out by volunteering your time as a steward at masses. If you are able to help us in this important work, please speak to one of the priests.

The Sacramental programmes for 2020 e.g. Reconciliation, First Holy Communion, Confirmation and RCIA are now completed and we have begun preparations for 2021. Meanwhile, let us continue to work together as a Christian community, keeping an eye out for each other, supporting each other practically and by prayer.

Since I am over 70, I am prohibited from visiting hospitals, nursing homes and private residences. I miss this part of my priestly ministry very much but continue to pray daily for the sick and housebound. Father Adrian is visiting and will be pleased to call on anyone who requires a visit.

The parish has suffered financially, so please continue to support it by making a donation and sending in your offertory envelopes also.

Let us not forget the poor and needy, CAFOD, SVP and the Missions. Our parish boundaries extend far beyond the Redbridge roundabout, James Lane and Aldersbrook. We have a responsibility for our sisters and brothers in the global parish - the wider world.
