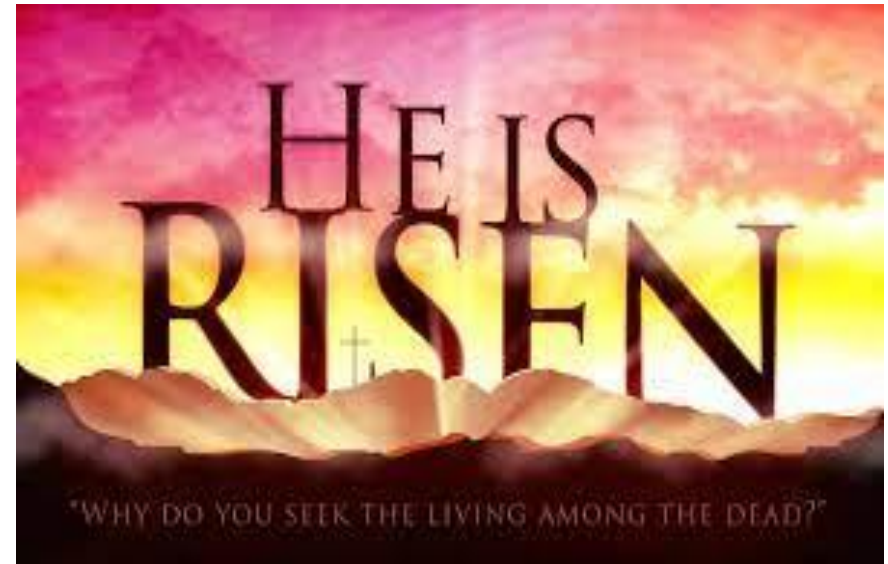

because you were in a hurry.*

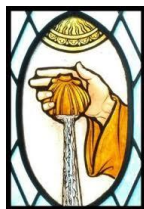
*And everything will be a miracle
