*Dear Parishioners,*

*As we begin (hopefully) to emerge from the restrictions of Covid, people are beginning to reflect on how they coped with lockdown. Some missed family and friends very much, others suffered bereavement and the pain of losing a loved one. Some could not cope with silence and others appreciated the silence. A person who lost a loved one said to me what I cannot cope with is the awful silence after nearly 50 years of married life. I was reading an article by an Irish priest Father Benignus O' Rourke OSA and he had the following to say about silence.*

*“In silence we may become aware of how much we feel, in some way or other, we are ‘victims’. Of course we have all in some way been the victims of other people’s anger, of their selfishness, of their ignorance. We may feel that school friends, teachers or colleagues, or possibly our families have done us harm, have destroyed our confidence. Buried hurts may have lain in our hearts unattended for years. They rise to the surface when we are quiet. So in our prayers we may become aware of having suffered injustice and we are upset about it. That is the first stage. The second is working with the feelings that come out of that awareness – our anger, our desire to get even, our resentment, our withdrawal, our coldness. When we examine the past we tend to find scapegoats and blame others for our problems but as we learn to sit in the Lord’s presence we face these hurts and begin to discover how to leave the past in God’s hands. Instead of blaming, we learn silence to accept the past with all its brokenness. We accept ourselves, our situation, all our confusion, dislocation and damage. We submit it quietly and with compassion for ourselves to the Lord. And we hear him say, “Do not be afraid. I am with you.”*

*As you know Cardinal George Pell was imprisoned for a crime he did not commit. It seems he was falsely accused and whilst in Prison he kept a journal and it is now published in book form – it is well worth reading – entitled ‘Prison Journal’ (by Ignatius Press). This is a prayer from that journal:*

*Loving God, you are our strength. Support us in our weakness, give us insight and wisdom, peace of heart and patience. Take us under your care, give us our love so that we will have the strength to embrace our weakness and confront our challenges. We make this prayer through Christ Our Lord. Amen.*

## **Sacramental Preparation**

### **Confirmation**

The sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated at OLOL Wanstead by Bishop Alan on the **evening of Friday February 11<sup>th</sup> 2022**.

Preparation for the sacrament in this parish involves 12 sessions, 4:30pm-6:00pm Sundays, spread over the year from September. Covid permitting, these will be held in the pastoral centre. It involves compulsory study between sessions, regular attendance at Mass, and increasing involvement in parish life, including participation in masses and social action in the parish. There is also a compulsory retreat weekend 26<sup>th</sup>-28<sup>th</sup> November 2021. Please note these dates and make sure you keep these dates free before you apply. Those in **Year 10 or above in school year 2021-2022**, who would like to be prepared for this sacrament should in the first instance personally contact Michaela Mouquet by email at: [michaelaololcc@gmail.com](mailto:michaelaololcc@gmail.com) Please give your full name, place and date of baptism (certificates of baptism will need to be provided at enrolment), address, school and school year. This is to enable planning of the programme to go ahead.

She also provides short term mentoring for up to 3 sessions for individuals and groups as well as writing and delivering bespoke modules and supporting businesses and organisations with mental health and wellbeing policy support. She is DBS checked and has safeguarding, teaching and, of course, youth work experience. Katharine has a set of courses running in June and July. The **Level 3 Supervising First Aid for Mental Health** course is the most comprehensive and runs on 16th and 23rd June and 7th and 14th July between 7:30pm and 9:15pm with the option of joining LIVE via Zoom or catching up on the recording. There is also an assessment arranged to suit you. There will also be a **Level 2 First Aid for Youth Mental Health** course running on 20th and 27th July between 7:30pm and 9:15pm with the same LIVE or recorded options, along with an assessment.
