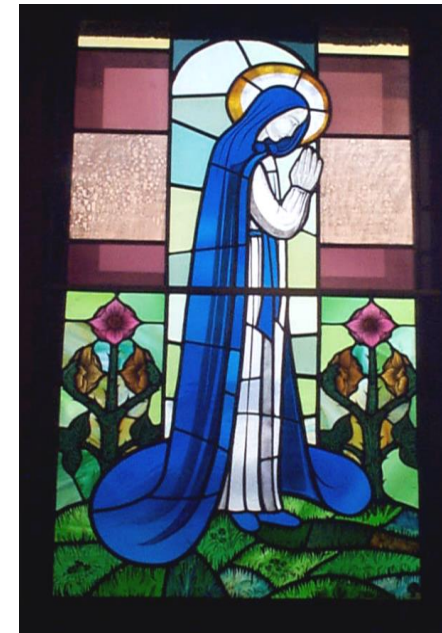

COVID – SAFETY REGULATIONS IN OUR CHURCH

Following the publications by the Government and the Bishops Conference Step 4 Guidance Notes, we will begin to ease restrictions in our Church. Starting today we ask the following to be observed.

1. Ventilation of Church, windows and doors to be left open.
2. You are encouraged to sanitise hands on entering and exiting the Church.
3. You are encouraged to wear a face mask.
4. Seating will be back to pre-pandemic arrangements with the exception of the middle area on the right facing from Altar. That will continue to be roped off for those who wish to socially distance.
5. You will not be guided to your seat, you will be responsible for seating yourself. There will be a choice to where you can sit and social distance.
6. We will return to normal reception of Holy Communion practice. The ushers will guide people one row at a time.
7. Toilets are still unavailable except in an emergency.
8. Candles may be lit.
9. The offertory collection envelopes may be placed in the basket in the foyer.
10. The chains and ties will be removed except in the designated socially distanced areas.
11. Please exit from the Church by the designated exit doors.

All parishioners are asked to exercise responsibility for your actions and cooperate fully with the requirements. All these regulations are for the health and safety of everyone. If you are displaying any cold or flu symptoms do not attend Church. Thank you for your cooperation and hopefully we will get back to normality in due course. God bless yours for the month ahead and if you are going on holiday – ENJOY!
