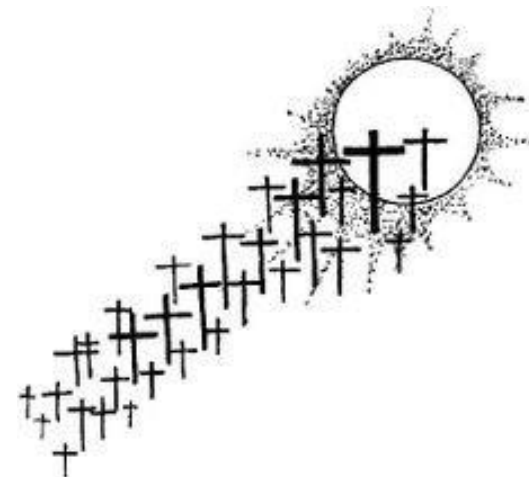

***Dear Parishioners,***

The month of November is with us again. In the Catholic tradition it is the month of the Holy Souls when we remember to pray for our beloved dead, who taught us so much and with whom we shared so much. Memory is a precious gift so let us remember to pray this month for those we have known and loved, that they may rest in peace and rise in glory. Many of those we remember were holy people, saints – we are all called to be saints. A good catholic practice is to attend daily Mass a few times a week during November to pray for our dead. Saint Monica, the Mother of Saint Augustine, made the request to her sons “All I ask is that you remember me at the altar of God”. The following few lines demonstrates something of what a Saint is:

#### GOD’S WORK OF ART

We are all different, all unique, all God’s work of Art.  
We remember today all our saints, in our families and groups,  
All the human race who have reached God.  
Each person, man or woman, young or old,  
Mirrors something of the face of God.  
We see the face of Christ in each other.  
And there is a common thread which unites us all:  
Our need for love and community, for home and acceptance,  
For love, respect, forgiveness.

The feast celebrates those gone before us and proclaims with love  
That the finest common thread among us  
Is that we are children of God, friends of Jesus Christ  
And the place where God’s glory dwells.  
We are all called to be Saints, to bloom where we are planted  
And to try to be Christ to each other.  
As we go through the month of November,  
Let us pray for the dead and the living.
