## ***Dear Parishioners,***

The Lord's Prayer, The Our Father, is among the best known of our Catholic prayers. It is the first many of us learned at our Mothers and Fathers knees. Perhaps it has become so familiar that we take it for granted. The following reflection on this beautiful prayer may help us to appreciate its meaning and beauty.

### **DO NOT SAY - OUR FATHER!**

Do not say '*FATHER*', if every day you do not behave like a son or daughter.

Do not say '*OUR*', if you live isolated in your egoism.

Do not say '*WHO ART IN HEAVEN*', if you are only thinking of the things of earth.

Do not say '*HALLOWED BE THY NAME*', if the one name that you are really concerned about is your own.

Do not say '*THY KINGDOM COME*', if it is your own kingdom that you are trying to build.

Do not say '*THY WILL BE DONE*', if you cannot accept sorrows.

Do not say '*GIVE US THIS DAY OUR DAILY BREAD*', if you are not worried about those who suffer hunger.

Do not say '*FORGIVE US OUR TRESPASSES AS WE FORGIVE THOSE WHO TRESPASS AGAINST US*', if you harbor rancor against your brother or sister.

Do not say '*LEAD US NOT INTO TEMPTATION*', if you are not prepared to avoid situations in which you are tempted.

Do not say '*DELIVER US FROM EVIL*', if you do not put yourself against what is evil.

Do not say '*AMEN*', if you have not understood or have not taken seriously the words of the '*Our Father*'.

## ARE YOU CARING FOR A CHILD WHO IS NOT YOURS?

Private fostering is when someone who is not a close relative cares for another person's child under the age of 16 (18 if disabled) for 28 days or more. A close relative is considered to be an aunt, uncle, grandparent, step parent or siblings. Friends of the family and other family members such as cousins or great aunts are not classed as close relatives for the purposes of Private Fostering, neither are families hosting overseas students who are being educated in the UK. You need to legally notify us of any private fostering arrangements in Redbridge to ensure the child is safe.
