PRAYING FOR THE HOLY SOULS IN NOVEMBER

November is traditionally been the month in the Church when we pray for the dead. When we die our soul leaves our body and if we are not yet ready to come fully into God's presence then it undergoes cleansing and healing in something we call purgatory (literally where we are purged of any unrepented everyday sins and healed of the effects that our sins have had on us). It is a temporary state and souls do not remain in purgatory forever.

The souls in purgatory that are being made ready to be fully with God are healed and restored by only one thing and one person - that is the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Forgiveness and mercy come from the Cross and it is the Lord who cares for each soul in purgatory, it is the Lord who works to bring them into his presence. When we have a Mass said for the dead or pray for them, we are praying for them as we would for anyone who is undergoing healing and treatment of any kind.

Our annual Mass for deceased parishioners will be celebrated at 8pm on Monday 28th November. As is customary on this occasion it will be possible to light a candle for a deceased loved one. This will happen automatically for all who have died in the parish in the past 12 months but it will also be possible to light a candle for others who have died in the past. Candles will be available on the night and a £5 donation is requested. November is the month of the Holy Souls when the Church asks us to remember our beloved dead, that they may rest in peace and rise in glory.

We also have our book of those who have died at the entrance to the Blessed Sacrament Chapel and a box where you can put the names of deceased of those whom you would like to be prayed for and remembered at Mass.
