Wednesday 1st November is the Solemnity of All Saints and is a Holy Day of Obligation. Vigil Mass at 7.00 p.m. on Tuesday 31st October and Mass at 9.00 a.m. on Wednesday 1st November.

WE REMEMBER OUR DEAD and the communion that we still enjoy with them during this month of November. We also pray and offer Masses for the repose of their souls in the eternal life of God.

Why do we offer Mass for the dead? We believe that there exists a living communion between us and our brothers and sisters "who have gone ahead of us marked the sign of faith". Just as we pray for each other and share each other's burdens on earth, we can offer prayers and sacrifices to help the departed souls undergoing purification, and no better prayer can be offered than that of the holy sacrifice of the Mass.

It is a deep and ancient instinct for Catholics to pray and offer Mass for the dead. St. Ambrose (d. 397) preached, "We have loved them during life; let us not abandon them in death, until we have conducted them by our prayers into the house of the Lord." St. Augustine (d. 430) recorded the dying wishes of his mother, St. Monica in his *Confessions*: "One thing only I ask you, that you remember me at the altar of the Lord wherever you may be." Pope St. Gregory (d. 604) said, "Let us not hesitate to help those who have died and to offer our prayers for them."

How do you offer a Mass for a deceased person?

- i) Please use one of the Mass intention envelopes available at the entrance to the Church.
- ii) There is no payment for having a Mass said for a deceased loved one, but you may wish to make an offering. In this way, you participate more intimately in the sacrifice of the Mass
