WORLD YOUTH SUNDAY This year, on the weekend of the 25th and 26th November, we (along with the rest of the world) will celebrate "World Youth Sunday", a chance to celebrate the role and significance of young people within our church.

Each year, this is a huge opportunity for us, as the Brentwood Catholic Youth Service and Walsingham House at Abbotswick, to not only raise some vital funds which allow us to continue to support and nurture the youth of our Diocese, but also to reach them and those who work with them.

Over 150 young people and leaders from around the Diocese joined our Youth Pilgrimages to Lourdes and World Youth Day this Summer, many of you will have had confirmation groups attend a retreat at Walsingham House over the last few years, and many of the young people at your local Catholic Schools will have visited, so hopefully you can already see the impact and importance of our work within your own Parishes and local area.⁶ Would you like to be one of those pilgrims and travel to Rome? At this stage, we are just trying to gauge what interest there might be in a parish pilgrimage that year and we are suggesting the following dates as possibilities: 19 - 23 May 2025 or 26 - 30 May 2025 (which is a half term). If you might be interested in both or one of the dates, please sign up on sheets in the church entrances.

How do you offer a Mass for a deceased person?

i) Please use one of the Mass intention envelopes available at the entrance to the Church.

ii) There is no payment for having a Mass said for a deceased loved one, but you may wish to make an offering. In this way, you participate more intimately in the sacrifice of the Mass offered, by making a sacrifice of your own and you help support and provide for the physical needs of the clergy.

iii) Please hand in your envelope to the office and Eileen, the parish secretary, who will allocate a date and time for the Mass to be said either in the parish or the Mass will be offered by a priest elsewhere.

Due to the large number of intentions waiting to be said, Mass intentions can be sent to priests in other parts of this country or abroad who have very few Mass intentions of their own and who have very limited resources. Please indicate on the envelope whether you are happy to have the Mass intention celebrated by a priest outside the parish.

iv) You may want to send a Mass card to the family of the deceased. Mass cards are available to purchase in the Repository after the 9.30 a.m. Sunday Mass.
