Church Homeless Charity has deep roots in the Christian Church here in England. Anyone can, through no fault of their own and regardless of their background, find themselves living on the streets. They believe in giving everyone the tools and experience to rebuild their lives. A little money goes a long way and can make a big difference to someone.

They have recently helped a lady who had mental health issues who was previously sectioned and found herself homeless. She is now living in supported accommodation and is studying at college and CHC supported her by purchasing books and a laptop to help her rebuild her life.

A young adult who was put in care at 14 is now starting his adult life and got an apprenticeship but needed help with the cost of setting up his first home, with no family to help CHC provided a grant to help him.

## ADVENT AND PREPARING FOR CHRISTMAS

The coming weeks are busy with gift buying, eating and drinking. These very human ways of celebrating Christmas remind us that in Jesus, God took human flesh and that he really did come into the reality of our human lives. But Advent is not only an opportunity to celebrate Christ's birth but also to prepare ourselves for when he will come again. St Cyril of Jerusalem reminds us of this double meaning of Advent:

We do not preach only one coming of Christ, but a second as well, much more glorious than the first. The first coming was marked by patience; the second will bring the crown of divine kingdom.

At the first coming he was wrapped in swaddling clothes in a manger. At his second coming he will be clothed in light as in a garment. In the first coming he endured the cross, despising the shame; in the second coming he will be in glory, escorted by an army of angels.

Below are some suggestions that might focus our spiritual preparation for this great and joyful Feast.

ADVENT RECONCILIATION SERVICE will take place from 7.00 p.m. on Thursday 14th December. An opportunity to meet the Lord who offers us the forgiveness, peace and healing that alone has the power to renew and restore our lives. A number of priests will be available to hear confessions.
