

fervour, new methods and a new expression for the announcing and witnessing of the Gospel." Our parish is called to embrace this impulse of missionary transformation.

Guided by the Holy Spirit, the *Laetare weekend* will allow us to reflect on the ways that we can live in Christ and make known God's grace to people beyond the walls of the church.

The weekend will begin with a simple community supper on *Friday 8th March* followed by Stations of the Cross, led by members of the Sion Community.

On the morning of *Saturday 9th March*, there will be a working breakfast where we will be able to reflect on those areas of our parish life that need attention if our community is to have a more missionary outlook.

During that afternoon, the Church will be open and set up with Prayer Stations in the Church where people will be able to pray alone or with someone else. In the hall, there will be refreshments and activities for our children and their families. The afternoon will conclude before the evening Mass with a special Holy Hour before the Blessed Sacrament.

The Sion community will lead the music at Masses this weekend and the children's liturgy. More details to follow, but do make a note of the dates of the parish mission.

All are very welcome. **MORNING FOR MINISTERS OF HOLY COMMUNION** The most holy Eucharist is the "source and the summit" of all that the Church is and does. At its heart is the real presence of the crucified and Risen Lord, who continues his saving work among us. Thus, Ministers of Holy Communion play a hugely important role in the life of any parish community and their formation is important.

A sincere thank you to all the men and women Ministers of Holy Communion who serve our community in this way.

Ministers of Holy Communion are commissioned for the primary role of assisting the priest with the distribution of Holy Communion. Some Ministers will also take Holy Communion to any sick or housebound members of our parish family. But being a Minister of Holy Communion should not be considered as a practical function.

The reception of Holy Communion is a sacred action, an opportunity for encounter with Christ himself who offers himself to us under the forms of Bread and Wine. His offering of himself has to be met by faith if a life giving encounter and deep personal communion is to take place. Ministers of Holy Communion have a great contribution to make in assisting the assembly to receive the sacrament reverently and fruitfully. They do this through the witness of their own lives and by the reverence they show for this Sacrament of Christ's love for us.

On Saturday 24th February 9.00 a.m. - 12 noon, there will be a morning of formation and reflection for our present Ministers of Holy Communion in order to help them reflect a little more deeply on their role and to consider some practical questions. The morning will be led by Fr Gary Dench, the Diocesan Director of Liturgy, and Fr Martin.
