

FEAST OF THE ASCENSION Pope Francis writes: "Jesus is the one eternal High Priest who with his Passion passed through death and the tomb and ascended into heaven. He is with God the Father where he intercedes for ever in our favour (cf. Heb 9:24). As St John says in his First Letter, he is our Advocate: How beautiful it is to hear this! When someone is summoned by the judge or is involved in legal proceedings, the first thing he does is to seek a lawyer to defend him. We have One who always defends us, who defends us from the snares of the devil, who defends us from ourselves and from our sins!

...we have this Advocate; let us not be afraid to turn to him to ask forgiveness, to ask for a blessing, to ask for mercy! The Ascension of Jesus into heaven acquaints us with this deeply consoling reality on our journey: in Christ, true God and true man, our humanity was taken to God. Christ opened the path to us. He is like a roped guide climbing a mountain who, on reaching the summit, pulls us up to him and leads us to God. If we entrust our life to him, if we let ourselves be guided by him, we are certain to be in safe hands, in the hands of our Saviour, of our Advocate.

ROME 19th—23rd MAY 2025 UPDATE We now need to proceed with this and get it booked up. The cost for four nights in a single room is £645 and for those sharing is £575. This does not include flights. What is included is 4 nights bed and breakfast with supper on the day of arrival and lunch on the day of departure, all transport to and from the airports in both countries, entrance fee to the Catacombs, a full itinerary with tickets for the Papal audience and opportunities to visit all the major sites with a visit to The English College and their summer residence Palazzola, daily Mass. The flights have not yet been released, but are likely to be up to £300 per person with luggage but may indeed be considerably less than that.
